**Promise:**

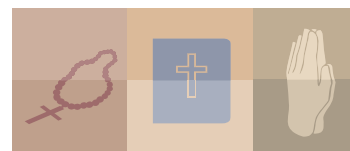
I love you. My truth is available for all.
