

James "Butch" Murphy




James was born and raised in Michigan, and with all his travels and experiences, has always called Michigan home. While still a senior in high school, James made a decision to surrender the rest of his life to Christ. That decision has had a major impact on the path of his life thus far.

James's interest in the world has found him prospecting in Alaska, doing archaeological research in Central and South America, and trekking around the world. He has held many jobs in his life; and on one occasion, he even served as a bodyguard for Mother Theresa. He has been a guest on the 700 Club, the EWTN network, and has helped create videos for national broadcasts.

In 1989 James took up a cross on a journey that would change his life forever. He walked across the state of Michigan carrying a 6-foot cross evangelizing and praying for our state. His pilgrimage didn't stop there; and in 1992, he journeyed on foot 4200 miles-18 months and 14 pairs of shoes later, across the entire United States.

James is also a former chairman and currently a consultant to the National Service Committee for the Catholic Charismatic Renewal. He is a former producer of "The Choices We Face", a weekly television program of Renewal Ministries. He is a past chairman of the Youth Executive Committee for the North American Renewal Service Committee, an ecumenical organization. James is currently a director of the Leadership Formation for the International Catholic Charismatic Renewal Service (ICCRS), whose offices are located at the Vatican in Rome.

Reverend Bishop Paul J. Bradley, bishop of the Diocese of Kalamazoo. Bishop Bradley was installed in June 2009 as the fourth bishop of Kalamazoo. Bishop Bradley was appointed titular bishop of Afufenia and auxiliary bishop of the Diocese of Pittsburgh on December 16, 2004 and was ordained on February 2, 2005. During his first year as bishop for the more than 100,000 Catholics in the nine-county region of the Diocese of Kalamazoo, Bishop Bradley visited all 59 Parishes and 22 Catholic schools in the diocese. He released his first pastoral letter, What I have Heard and Seen in the fall of 2010.
